Situated deep in the national park on the ephemeral Luwi River, Time + Tide Luwi Camp is wonderfully remote, with no other camps for miles around. Tranquility envelops this camp, creating a wilderness haven that allows you to reconnect with nature in a meaningful way. Nestled in a grove of ancient mahogany trees, the tented suites are designed to fully immerse guests into the bush experience. From the comfort of your open air lounge, watch the diverse wildlife wandering by on the grassy floodplains. Listen to the hippos bellowing in the nearby lagoon and breathe in the heady aroma of African jasmine drifting past on a cool breeze. Sit back and let the peace of this place wash over you.



## CAMP DETAILS

### THE SUITES

- + 5 suites - one bed, one bath
- + Open air bathroom, outdoor shower
- + Private open air seating area
- + Double or twin configuration
- + Fans in bedrooms
- + Solar power, British three pin plugs in main lounge
- + No wifi and phone signal
- + Main lodge - dining area, lounge, bar and campfire

### NEED TO KNOW

- + Open 20 May to 31 October
- + Minimum age 12
- + 2 hr game drive transfer from Mfuwe

## GREAT ALL SEASON

- + South Luangwa is famous for large elephant herds
- + The Luwi region is a haven for walking safaris
- + Wildlife photography - still a wild land devoid of crowds that makes for great photographic opportunities



September to November is best for seeing the iconic carmine bee-eaters.



As the dry season approaches, large herds of elephants begin to drop by camp more often, drawn to drink at the nearby lagoon.



Peak season for our signature Sleepout Under the Stars is July to October.

This is also a wonderful way to gain a more in-depth perspective on the bush. Combine walks with game drives and ventures upriver to find elusive roan antelope, eland and hartebeest. Next to camp, a permanent oxbow lagoon attracts wildlife from far and wide, especially during the dry winter months. A wildlife hide overlooks the resident hippos and offers superb sightings of the lagoon's many visitors - perfect for photography!

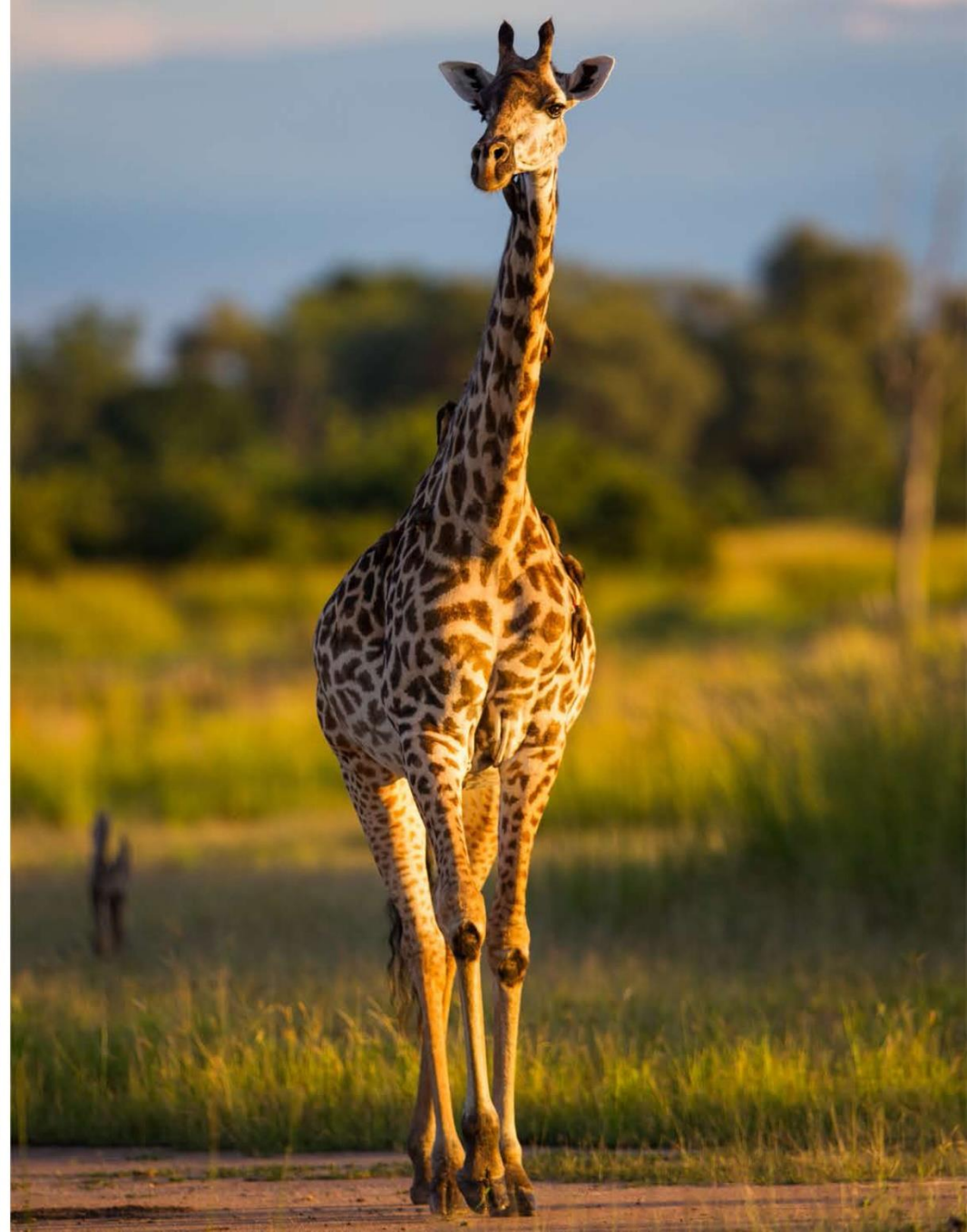
